

RESOLUTION FIXING THE EMPLOYER'S CONTRIBUTION UNDER THE
PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' MEDICAL AND HOSPITAL CARE ACT

- WHEREAS, (1) Government Code Section 22825.6 provides that a local agency contracting under the Public Employees' Medical and Hospital Care Act shall fix the amount of the employer's contribution at an amount not less than the amount required under Section 22825 of the Act, and
- WHEREAS, (2) Reclamation District NO. 1000 is a local agency contracting under the Act; now, therefore be it
- RESOLVED, (a) That the employer's contribution for each employee or annuitant shall be the amount necessary to pay the full cost of his/her enrollment, including the enrollment of family members, in a health benefits plan or plans up to a maximum of \$404.00 with respect to employees or annuitants enrolled for self alone, \$808.00 for an employee or annuitant enrolled for self and one family member, and \$1,050.00 for an employee or annuitant enrolled for self and two or more family members plus administrative fees and Contingency Reserve Fund assessments.
