

Resolution No. 2013-11

In Recognition of Terrie A. Figueroa for 25 Years of Service to Reclamation District No. 1000

WHEREAS, Terrie A. Figueroa started work at Reclamation District No. 1000 on November 1 1988 as the District Secretary and Clerk of the Board; and,

WHEREAS, during her tenure Terrie provided support for two General Managers and twenty-two different District Trustees while serving as the District Secretary for 25 years the longest term for anyone in the 100 –year history of the District; and,

WHEREAS, Terrie not only served as District Secretary and Board Clerk during the historic floods of January 1995, January 1997 and January to March 2006 and District’s emergency response protecting the lives and properties of those in the District; but also during the great office fire of 2004 requiring temporary relocation to a small trailer while the office was restored and,

WHEREAS, during her 25 years, Terrie saw the District transition from a low-keyed agricultural district to a busy urban district and she developed her technological, financial and inter-personal skills to assist the District’s management, field staff and Board during this critical transition period; and,

WHEREAS, though her title may not reflect it, she served as the “hub” of the District’s wheel interfacing with the public, staff, General Manager, Trustees, contractors, vendors and consultants balancing her duties and responsibilities to insure the District wheel never fell off; and ,

WHEREAS, though dealing with these difficult challenges and diverse responsibilities Terrie always came to work with a smile and became the face of the District to the outside world all the while performing her duties in a professional manner with a strong work ethic not leaving until the job was done to her standards.
