

ACTION ITEMS

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

1A) Regular Meeting – December 10, 2004

Motion by Trustee Chase approve the minutes of the December 10, 2004 Board meetings as presented. Seconded by Trustee Christophel, duly put and carried.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

2A) Treasurer's Report – December 2004

The Treasurer's Report for December 2004 is as follows:

Motion by Trustee Gilbert to approve the Treasurer's Report for December 2004 as presented. Seconded by Trustee Lauppe, duly put and carried.

2B) EXPENDITURE REPORT–December 2004

The expenditures for the month of December 2004 were \$245,138.45. Warrants 7225 & 7226 were issued in the amount of \$200,000.00.

3) Sacramento River Erosion Site Report Presentation – MBK

Gil Cosio and Rick Reinhardt from MBK reviewed the recent Sacramento River Erosion Site Report prepared for the District. New sites were noted, and changes from the 1999 report were cited. Additionally, Mr. Cosio showed the board a sample of the work that MBK has been involved in to repair erosions sites in other areas. The board discussed using some of those environmentally friendly

construction methods as a proactive measure where there is adequate berm remaining and the erosion is not into the levee profile.

District Engineer Clifton stated that Pete Rabbon of the Department of Water Resources has sent out a letter to Reclamation District's admonishing them to repair the erosion sites on their levees. District Engineer Clifton forwarded the letter to the District's attorneys at Downey, Brand. Downey, Brand will be responding with a letter reminding DWR that channel maintenance is a State responsibility and that the Reclamation District's are responsible for maintenance of the levee not the river banks. District Engineer Clifton believes the State will attempt to get legislation started, making the responsibility for bank protection a local responsibility. The District will have to be vigilant. The Flood Control Association is going to employ Bob Reed to lobby on behalf of the local districts. There will be a special assessment charged for the lobbying efforts.

There are several bills drafted at legislative counsel regarding how flood control costs will be paid for, and one bill to exempt flood control costs from Proposition 218 coverage.

4) Committee Reports

Trustee Chase asked the status of scheduling a meeting with Bob Overstreet or the Mayor, and if the Urbanization Report has been sent to the Mayor's office. District Engineer Clifton stated that the copies of the report for distribution were received from Akiyama Architects and that he would draft a letter for Trustee Harris' signature before sending the reports out. The Urbanization Committee will schedule a meeting with the Mayor's office to review the report.

5A) Sacramento County Pooled Investment Fund Policy

It was moved by Trustee Gilbert to receive and accept the Sacramento County Pooled Investment Fund Policy as submitted. Seconded by Trustee Chase, duly put and carried.

Trustee Gilbert requested a copy of the Sacramento County Pooled Investment Fund Audit.

5B) Easement – Natomas Village Partners, LLC

District Engineer Clifton stated that the construction improvements along Truxel Blvd. and those planned for the construction of light rail will restrict access to the District's East Drain on the north side of Truxel. The property owner is granting an easement to the District to provide increased access to accommodate District canal operations and maintenance.

Motion by Trustee Christophel to accept the easement as presented. Seconded by Trustee Lauppe, duly put and carried.

5C) Election of Officers – Committee Assignments

Trustee Harris nominated Trustee Gilbert for President of the Board of Trustees. Trustee Gilbert declined the nomination.

Trustee Miller nominated Trustee Harris to continue to serve as President of the Board and Trustee Chase to continue to serve as the Vice President of the Board of Trustees. The nomination was seconded by Trustee Gilbert, duly put and carried.

5) **Engineer’s Report**

a) **Sacramento River Emergency Work Status**

District Engineer Clifton informed the Board that the tin building has been removed from the concrete structure and Nordic has put in a ramp to get to the site.

The board discussed using one of the methods outlined by MBK at the pump house site. District Engineer Clifton stated that he is not opposed to using debris boxes, if the erosion is not into the levee profile and the depth of the river in that location allows it. If the erosion is into the levee section then something else will have to be done to save the levee.

b) **Setback Levee Discussion**

Trustee Chase asked if the boxes could be used at River Mile 78, the location of the proposed setback levee. District Engineer Clifton stated that the river may be too deep in that location. SAFCA is still looking at alternatives for the site.

c. Office Rehabilitation Update

District Engineer Clifton stated that some contractors will refuse to bid because, they don't want to deal with prevailing wage issues and paperwork. Counsel for the insurance company has said prevailing wage applies. Counsel for the District does not believe that prevailing wage applies if the insurance company bids the contract. District Engineer Clifton stated when bids are received they will be 15 to 20% higher because of prevailing wage issues. The contract will be let by the District though the costs will be paid by the insurance company.

d. Bank Protection Issues

Other Matters

Trustee Chase suggested that the personnel committee meet early this year to discuss finding a replacement for District Engineer Clifton who is retiring at the end of the year. After discussion it was decided the personnel committee would meet on February 14, 2005 at 4:00 P.M. at Downey, Brand. Attorney Day has stated he will reserve a meeting room.



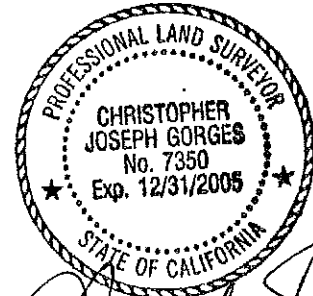

All that certain real property situate in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, described as follows:

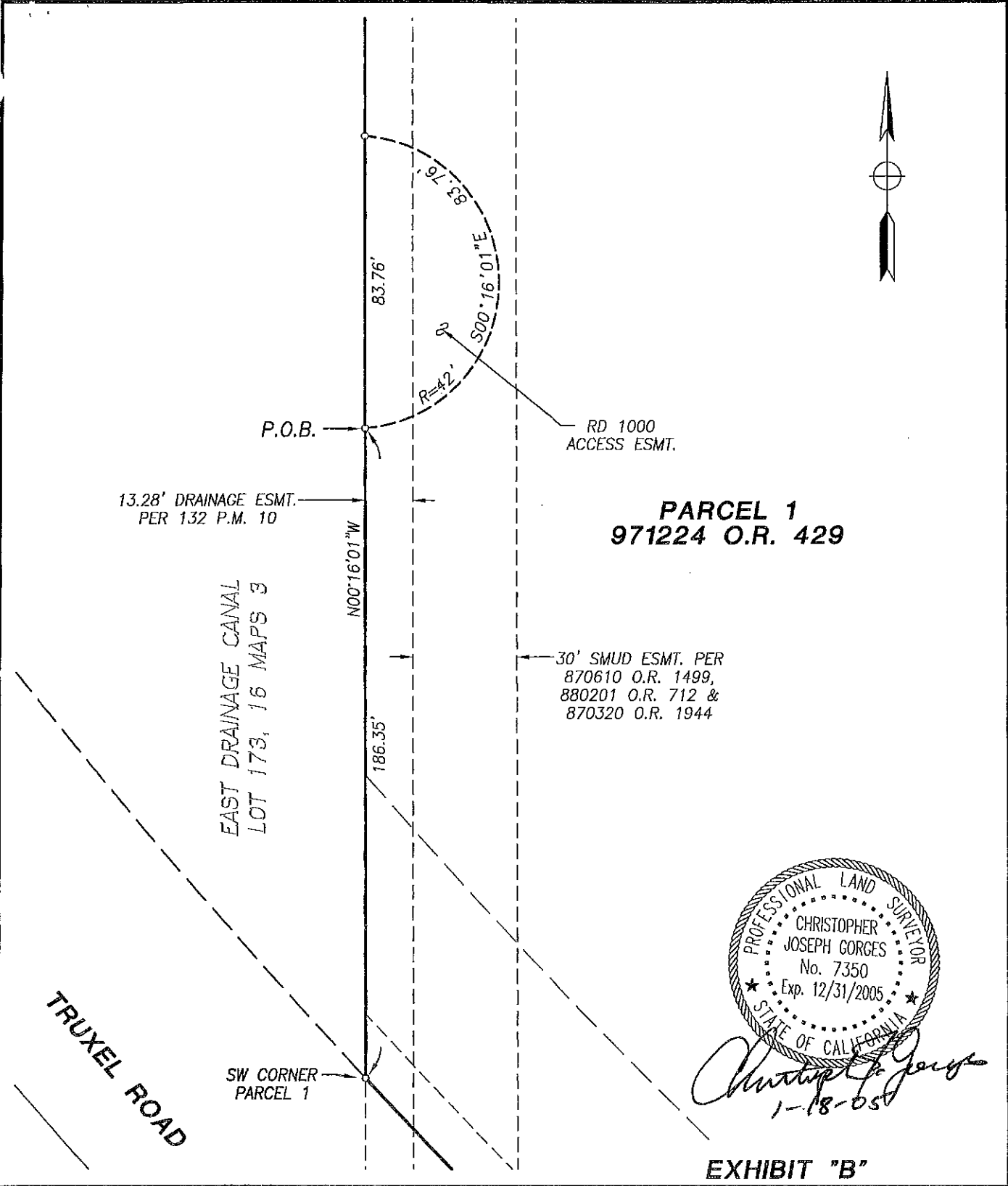
