To Whom It May Concern:

Reclamation District No. 1000 (RD 1000) plans to perform a levee maintenance project and is requesting bids.

Owner: Reclamation District No. 1000, Natomas Basin

Location: Sacramento County

Description of Work: The project consists of waterside vegetation control including mechanical mowing and tree trimming from Gateway Oaks to Truxel Road and from Powerline to the Natomas Cross Canal along the Sacramento River.

Plan Cost: \$20.00 (non-refundable). Plans and specifications are available at the offices of Reclamation District No. 1000.

Mandatory Pre-Bid: A mandatory pre-bid site inspection meeting is scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Monday, September 30, 2019. The meeting location will be at the offices of Reclamation District No. 1000, 1633 Garden Highway, Sacramento CA 95833.

NOTICE INVITING SEALED PROPOSALS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Reclamation District No. 1000, NATOMAS BASIN, hereinafter called the District is inviting sealed proposals or bids for "NATOMAS BASIN VEGETATION MAINTENANCE PROJECT."

Sealed bids addressed to "Natomas Basin VEGETATION MAINTENANCE PROJECT," c/o Reclamation District 1000, 1633 Garden Highway, Sacramento, California 95833, will be received by mail or hand delivery until 1:00 p.m. on October 7, 2019. The formal bid opening will take place at the offices of Reclamation District 1000, 1633 Garden Highway, Sacramento, California 95833, at 1:00 p.m. local time, on October 7, 2019, at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

The project consists of mechanical mowing and tree trimming from Gateway Oaks to Truxel Road and from Powerline to the Natomas Cross Canal along the Sacramento River. Grasses and weeds should be mowed to below 6 inches in height. Trees and shrubs less than 2 inches at diameter breast height are to be cut to grade and mulched in place. Tree branches need to be limbed up 5 feet off the ground. The waterside should be cleared down to the water's edge.

Work will be done and progressive payments made in accordance with and as more particularly described in the Specifications and Drawings.

Bids must be accompanied by a Proposal Guarantee amounting to ten percent (10%) of the bid as described in the Specifications. Said guarantee shall be applied toward any damages sustained by said District in case that bidder depositing the same does not within ten (10) days after written notice that the Contract has been awarded to him, (1) enter into a contract with the District and (2) furnish Performance Bond as described in the Specifications.

The District reserves the privilege of rejecting any and all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bids or in the bidding procedures, or to postpone the bid opening for good cause.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of thirty (30) days after the date set for opening the bids, within which time an award may be made.

It shall be mandatory upon the Contractor to whom the Contract is awarded and upon any subcontractor under him to pay not less than the specified rates to all workers employed by them in the execution of the Contract work.

The successful bidder, and each of his/her/its subcontractors, shall be required to comply with all local, State, and Federal labor laws and regulations. They shall be required to pay the local prevailing rate of per diem wages as established by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR). Copies of said wage rates are on file at the office of the District, and shall be made available to any interested party, on request.

In accordance with the provisions of section 22300 of the Public Contract Code, the Contractor may elect to receive 100% of payments due under the Contract from time to time, without retention of any portion of the payment, by entering into an Escrow Agreement for Security Deposits in Lieu of Retention.

At the time of Award of Contract, the successful Bidder must be in possession of at least a Class A General Engineering Contractor License or a C-27 Landscaping Contractor License issued by the California Contractors State License Board.

A mandatory pre-bid site inspection meeting is scheduled for Monday, September 30, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. at the designated location shown on the Project Location Map.

Plans and specifications, forms of proposals, bonds and contracts may be obtained at the office of Reclamation District 1000, 1633 Garden Highway, Sacramento, California 95833, at a price of \$20.00 per set (non-refundable) (checks made payable to "Reclamation District 1000").

Time limit for completion of the work is December 15, 2019.
